Counselors and kids performing skits


Drumming, guitar, and funny songs,

KIDS KAMP*

(AGES 4-12)

For a short session each day, camp staff are available to take your young children on a themed adventure throughout the camp grounds and provide supervision for a variety of age-appropriate activities. Parents then have a chance to relax and get their 'me' time. *Limited spaces available.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Families are assigned their own traditional camp cabin for the duration of their stay. If requested, families can share a cabin with another family. Cabin styles vary by area and can sleep from 4 to up to 12 family members. All beds are twin-size and bunk-bed style. Some cabins have bathrooms within the cabin while others have shower houses located a short walking distance away. All bathroom facilities include toilets, basins and hot showers. Cabins are rustic but do have electricity and screened windows, however they are not airconditioned. Parents are responsible for bringing their own cribs/playpens if needed.

MEALS

Our kid-friendly meals are served buffet-style in the Dining Hall, with plenty of options for all tastes, including vegetarian alternatives. Meals include a variety of entree selections with fresh fruit and beverages available throughout the day. Large salad, sandwich bar and delicious desserts will also be featured with lunch or dinner.
